In its youth, Fiano is often intensely flavored and aromatic with honey notes, that over time, develop into more spicy and nutty notes.

Bottle-aged Hunter Semillons exhibit a buttercup-yellow colour, burnt toast or honey characteristics on the nose and excellent complex flavours on the palate, with a long finish and soft acid. Young Hunter Valley semillon typically presents as a dry wine, boasting citrus flavours of lemon, lime or green apple.

## Pinot Noir

The aroma of Pinot Noir is often one of the most complex of all varieties. With ripe grape or black cherry aromas, frequently accented by a pronounced spiciness that suggests cinnamon or mint. Ripe tomato, mushroom and barnyard smells are common descriptors for identifying.

## Merlot & Merlot Blends

Merlot is a red grape that is used both as a blending grape and for varietal wines. Merlot based wines usually have medium body with hints of berry, plum and currant. Its softness and fleshiness, combined with early ripening, makes Merlot an ideal grape to blend with the late-ripening Cabernet Sauvignon.

## Grenache & Grenache Blends

Grenache is probably the most widely planted variety of red wine grape in the world. It is generally spicy with dark berry flavours. The aromas are powerful, including menthol, liquorice and black pepper. Because of its strong traits Grenache is usually blended with other grape varieties such as Shiraz and Mourvèdre.

## Malbec

Dense and chewy with tobacco, blackberry and a touch of mulberry. The palate is warm and generous with soft tannins that disappear behind the ample fruit.

## Zinfandel

Zinfandel typically produces a robust red wine style. The taste of the wine depends on the ripeness of the grapes from which it is made. Red berry fruit flavors like raspberry predominate in wines from cooler areas, whereas blackberry, anise and pepper notes are more common in wines made in warmer areas.

Bright and lifted with bursting lime, lemon zest and guava. Subtleties of jasmine, lemongrass, fennel bulb and coriander seed lie in the background. An elegant palate offers diligent texture through the middle, with a finely directed acid spine. Lemon features with finger lime, grapefruit and hints of lychee, whilst savoury notes of blanched almonds and anise offer complexity.

#### Leeuwin Siblings Shiraz 2016

Margaret River WA

Concentrated red cherries, mulberries and blueberries dominate the nose. There is cocoa, coffee bean, oak char black cardamom, nutmeg, cinnamon and lifted violets that are well positioned in the background. The palate is rich and layered with dark cherries, boysenberries and blueberries. Structural mocha-like tannins scroll to the back palate with subtle hints of anise, which is balanced with an elegant and bouyant acid line.

#### Leeuwin Prelude Chardonnay 2016

Margaret River WA

Lifted and fragrant with an abundance of limes, Nashi pears, white peaches and baby pineapples. Heightened with notes of jasmine, frangipani and lemon blossom. Nuances of nougat, cashew and toasted almonds combine with brioche, brulee and mealy notes lying beneath. The palate is bright, well weighted with volume and presence, whilst maintaining focus and definition. Pink grapefruit, white nectarine and baked apple feature with diligent oak and subtle texture. The layered and contoured mid palate is finely checked with mineral acid thread.

#### Leeuwin Prelude Cabernet Sauvignon 2013

Margaret River WA

A lifted, concentrated and layered nose, consisting of blackcurrants, red cherries and boysenberries. Fragrant violets, clove, anise, cassia bark and black cardamom suitably sit in the background. The palate is vibrant and tightly coiled with blackcurrant, cocoa and finely tuned oak. Subtle spice, underlying char and roasted coffee bean offer delicate complexity. Laced acidity with silky ripe tannins provides both length and balance.

#### Leeuwin Art Shiraz 2014

Margaret River WA

Concentrated blueberries, mulberries and plums give density to a nose that also exhibits black cardamom, anise caramel and hickory. There is subtle lift with rose petals and violets offering further fragrance. Black and blue fruits dominate the palate with upfront weight and texture. Woven fruit layers meet subtle smokey oak creating a layered palate, laced with a finely balanced acid line.

#### Leeuwin Art Cabernet Sauvignon 2013 **Special Back Vintage** Margaret River WA

\$170

A highly expressive and fragrant nose with violet, lavender, bay leaf and fennel seed weaving through a dense core of blackcurrant and red cherry. Subtle anise, cumin, cedar, cracked coffee bean and cocoa lie in the background. The palate has purity and elegance; delicate layers of cherries, blackcurrants and Satsuma plums combine with a vibrant thread of natural acidity, giving direction and focus. Cinnamon and clove are present on the mid-palate which extends long with tightly coiled powdery tannins.

#### Leeuwin Art Chardonnay 2013 **Special Back Vintage** Margaret River WA

\$249

A concentrated and vibrant aroma, highlighted by lime curd, juicy pears and lemon flesh in the foreground. Beneath lies subtle complexities of cinnamon quill, black cardamom, amongst toasted hazelnuts and pecans. An open, textural and layered entry continues to a youthful and fine palate with laced acidity and a seamless finish. Cut limes, pears and white peach dominate the palate, woven with savoury almonds, sweet spice and seamless elegant length.

## Shiraz | Shiraz Blends

In 1831, the Scotsman James Busby, often called “the Father of Australian viticulture”, made a trip back to Europe to collect cuttings from vines (primarily from France and Spain) for introduction to Australia. The cuttings were planted in the Sydney Botanical Gardens, and in Hunter Valley, and in 1839 brought from Sydney to South Australia.

# Dessert Wine

Semillon and Riesling produce most of Australia's 'sticky' wines. We offer a selection of Botrytis or "Noble Styles" where the Botrytis fungus attacks the grapes and increases their sugar levels. These wines show complex characters of lemon, apricot and honey. Cordon or Cane Cut, are where the vine branches [cordons] are cut and the fruit is cut off from the nutrients of the rest of the vine increasing the sugars in the grape, often producing a lighter style than Noble rot wines.
